School Goals:	 MFDES SMART Goal(s): Stretch Goal - By the year 2025, all 2nd grade students will leave MFDES reading on or above grade level. Annual Summative Goal(s) The percentage of 2nd grade students reading on grade level will increase a minimum of 8% points to 65% on EOY Star Renaissance testing. The percentage of 1st grade students reading on grade level will increase a minimum of 11% points to 60% on EOY Star Renaissance testing. The percentage of Kindergarten students at or above benchmark on MClass will increase a minimum of 14% to 75% on EOY MClass testing. All Pre-K students can identify all 26 capital and lowercase letters by May 2022.
