REPORTING SUSPECTED ABUSE, NEGLECT AND SELF-HARM - Aimee

- Wyoming state law (statues 14-3-205 & 35-20-103) states that any person who suspects child/vulnerable adult abuse, neglect or exploitation is required to report.
- According to Wyoming law, everyone must report suspected abuse, neglect or exploitation of child or vulnerable
 adult if they have reasonable cause to believe that it may be occurring. Child or adult abuse, neglect or
 exploitation has no boundaries according to sexual orientation, ethnic background, age, religion, disability, or
 gender, the reporting of abuse / neglect / exploitation of children and vulnerable adults is a 24-hour obligation.

- Report any suspected abuse, neglect or exploitation to Capella Morris or Aimee Fredrickson.
- While we are able to make reports, we are not able to determine if the reports will be investigated further, or what action will be taken by social services and/or law enforcement.

MCKINNEY-VENTO HOMELESS ACT

- Policy in a nutshell: if you suspect a student is homeless, let Aimee know.
- Migrant students are the same. If you suspect a student fits the following criteria, let Aimee know.
- Children and youth who are:
 - sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason
 - living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations;
 - living in emergency or transitional shelters or abandoned in hospitals;
 - Children and youths who have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for, or ordinarily used as, a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings;
 - Children and youths who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings; and
 - Migratory children who qualify as homeless because they are living in circumstances described above.

ATTENDANCE OVERVIEW

- New state statute changed the way we do attendance
- Teachers will mark a student **UNX** if they are not in class. If a parent has notified a teacher, please let the front office know so that the attendance code can be changed, but still mark the student **UNX**. The parent should contact the office to report an absence.
- **PVU** is a parent verified absence that is unexcused like going shopping, a siblings sporting event, needing extratime at home, etc.
- **PVE** is a parent verified absence for things like a funeral, religious obligation, or special circumstances pre-arranged with the school. This absence would already be verified if the office knows ahead of time.
- **PVI** is a parent verified illness for a student, their sibling, or a parent. This is also used for a last minute appointment. This absence can turn to a **MED** if it is cleared with a doctor's note. In addition, three consecutive days of **PVI** can be cleared by a school nurse if the family cannot afford healthcare.
- The attendance team (Elizabeth, Sarah, Aimee and Capella) will continue to reach out to families to encourage improved attendance.
