- What do you need to work on today?
- What is the most important thing for you to work on right now?
- What resources do you have for this class that can help you complete this work? (e.g. textbook, guided notes, notes from a lesson, examples, online texts, etc.)
 - In other words How did you learn about this topic?
 - Let's take a look at that resource and see if we can figure it out.
- Let's look at your weekly "to-do" list (either from Academic Workshop or on Google Classroom.)
- Let's open up Google Classroom for your _____ class.
- Check Infinite Campus for ______ class to see if there is anything missing.
- Show me what you are working on in _____ class.
- What is your most successful class? What are you doing to achieve this success? How can you transfer that to this class?
- Can I help you get organized? Where do you keep track of homework? Do you use a planner?

If students say...

- 1. I don't have anything to work on.
- 2. I'm completely finished with all my work.
- 3. I understand all my math (or other work).

Tutors can say...

- 1. Okay, I'll just hang here for a bit in case you need me.
- 2. Okay, let's see what you completed in (Class x)
- 3. Okay, let's see what you're working on.
- Do a few more problems to show you understand.
