- Tuesday-Thursday:Breakout sessions are considered Tier 2 and should be used to re-teach essential learning and offer a pyramid of support.
- Monday and Friday sessions can provide homework help, make up assignments, conference with students, and offer enrichment/extra-curricular opportunities.
- Any student can be required to attend a specific breakout session.
- Each rotation will last 1-3 weeks.
- Each team should offer at least two open sessions for homework, make-up work, and assignment help on Mondays and Fridays.
- Elective teachers have priority on Mondays and Fridays followed by Science and Social Studies.
- Students not required to attend a breakout session will earn the privilege to attend an open breakout session such as enrichment in the media center, cafeteria, or attend fine arts sessions.
- Students should check Flexisched every morning.
- After homeroom, students will transition to the Bulldog Breakout Session. 8:20AM-8:55AM
- Teachers will take attendance in Flexisched daily.
- If you are missing students and know they are at school, call the main office.
- Flexisched should be updated each Friday afternoon.

Weekly Schedule:
