### Kindergarten

- Reading
  - General Education – By the end of the school year, the percent of Kindergarten students who are proficient on the Star Early Literacy assessment will increase from 18% to 80%.
    - Progress as of Jan. 2022 - 59% proficient
  - SPED - By the end of the school year, the percent of Kindergarten students who are proficient on the Star Early Literacy assessment will increase from 18% to 80%.
    - Progress as of Jan. 2022 - 50% proficient
  - ELL - By the end of the school year, the percent of Kindergarten students who are proficient on the Star Early Literacy assessment will increase from 0% to 80%.

### First Grade

- Reading

- Math

- Math

    - Progress as of Jan. 2022 - 0% proficient
  - ELL - By the end of the school year, the percent of Fifth Grade students who are proficient on the Star Reading assessment will increase from 17% to 70%.
    - Progress as of Jan. 2022 - 50% proficient
- Math

- Reading

- Math
