Objectives Posted on the Board

- □ Must be posted in the "We will/I will" format
- □ Must be present for entire lesson
- □ Must be legible no matter where a student sits in the room
- $\hfill\square$ Must be referred to at the beginning, middle, and end of the lesson

Daily, Trackable Exit Ticket

- □ Must be formatted to check the skill from the "I will" and align with the expectations on the Weekly Formative Assessment
- $\hfill\square$ Must be able to know what each individual student answered
- □ Must be able to look at overall data to determine future lesson planning
- □ Must be common between teaching teams

Collect Data During Lecture

Utilize an instructional tool during lecture and note taking.

- Quizizz, Nearpod, GoFormative, Pear Deck, Plickers, and/or Poll Everywhere.
- Remember, the instructional tool is used to enhance student engagement and achievement, not to completely replace the lesson. Teachers should strategically plan 2 to 3 individual questions throughout the lecture/note taking portion of the lesson to check for understanding.
- These questions are separate from the warm up and exit ticket.
- This does not replace the weekly formative assessments planned during PLC team meeting times.

<u>Team Time</u>

- □ Teams will follow their collective commitments and focus on their team goals
- □ Teams will utilize the shared agenda to answer the 4 critical questions
- □ Teams will create plans for individual student intervention/reteach of essentials
- □ "Above all else...we strive for student growth"
