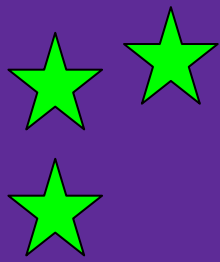

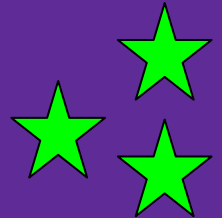

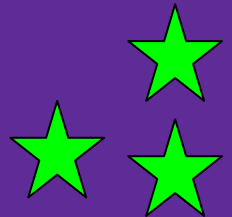
Our goal is to work together as a team, and support each other, in order to increase student achievement.

- ★ We will remain positive and respectful.



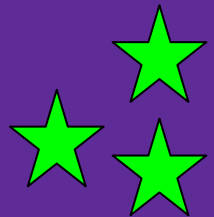


CREATING A CULTURE OF EXCELLENCE
