Our Mission: We will ensure all students reach their potential.

19-20 School SMART Goal: CMS will be at state average or above in our testing of 7th grade math, 7th grade English, 8th grade math, 8th grade English, and 8th grade science.

ELA Smart Goals:

Forty percent of CMS seventh graders and thirty one percent of CMS eighth graders will score proficient or advanced on the state reading test in 2020.

Forty percent or more of our seventh graders at CMS will score at or above standard in language on the state reading test in 2020.

Thirty seven percent of our seventh graders at CMS will score at or above standard in reading foundations/writing processes.

At least 17 of our 39 eighth grade EL students will score at or above proficient on the state reading test in 2020.

Forty three percent or more of our eighth graders will score at or above standard in language on the state reading test in 2020.

Thirty nine percent of our eighth graders at CMS will score at or above standard in reading foundations/writing processes.

At least seven of our thirty three eighth grade EL students will score at or above proficient on the state reading test in 2020.
