- Follow essential standards developed by the county level collaborative teams from each school.
- Developed curriculum maps during collaborative planning groups to determine pacing, rigor, and assessment methods.
- Common formative assessments developed by grade level teams.
- Collaborative teams meet weekly to delve into the results of CFA's to determine strengths and weaknesses so students can participate in flexible and fluid Tier 2 reengagement time and extension.
- ASIT (Academic School Intervention Team) meets monthly to analyze and discuss academic data for our TIER 3 students.
- BSIT (Behavior School Intervention Team) meets monthly to analyze and discuss behavior data and intervention strategies for our Tier 3 students.
- Title 1 Parent Coordinator who organizes workshops for parents. Parent coordinator also maintains resources for parents in the parent room.

Schoolwide Goals:

- Reading benchmark scores at or above grade level will increase by 15% between the fall and spring tests in order to better prepare students for then next grade.
- Math benchmark scores at or above grade level will increase by 15% between the fall and spring tests in order to better prepare students for the next grade.
- The percentage of students in k-2 missing 6 days or more will decrease by 3% this school year.
- We will have school wide smart goals, grade level team goals, and unit smart goals.
