

## HHS Achievement Data

It's important to understand that traditional school achievement data (standardized test score- WYTOPP and ACT) do not paint the most accurate picture of the teaching and learning that happens at Horizon High School. Often grade level cohorts consist of ten or less students. The most students we would have in one grade level testing cohort might be fifteen. Of the students in these cohorts, probably only half of them would have been a student at Horizon the entire year that they tested. An even smaller percentage would have been a student at Horizon for two or three consecutive years. As a result, one student can really skew an average. Therefore to really evaluate our work with PLCs and interventions we like to look at our school end summer school referral data. At the end of the year, this is the number of students we are referring to summer school because they did not demonstrate proficiency, through traditional means or through one of the layers of intervention, in at least one quarter or more core classes. This data show a trend that is decreasing, which supports the idea that our intervention system is becoming more effective.

Our graduation data is following an upward trend as well. Although we would prefer rates to be much higher, we understand they are low. We give all students a shot at Horizon, at least once. We take on students that haven't been in school for years, that have severe attendance and behavior issues. We take students that have dropped out of school already. Understanding this, we know from the get go that chances are higher that our students will not graduate. Even so, we've managed to start an upward trend with graduation rates the last five years since we've been doing the PLC work. Last year we posted our second highest rate in ten years. We believe we're headed the right direction.
