Elevate our guaranteed and viable curriculum that was built using Wyoming/National performance standards. Essential Learnings (WyTOPP Blueprints) will be the vehicle to enduring mastery of skills (ACT Standards). Evidence of Effectiveness will be determined by 75% of HSCHS Graduates qualifying for the Opportunity Level of Hathaway. (ACT 19+/GPA 2.5+)

Establish a baseline expectation that at least 70% of 9th & 10th graders will meet or exceed the Wyoming Benchmark on WyTOPP in Reading, Math and Science. Additionally, 4 of the 5 tested groups will achieve 35% advanced proficient.

Goal 3: Increase students scoring an ACT of 21+ to 60% or more and increase students scoring an ACT of 25+ to 25%. Raise the Bar, Close the GAP: 2006 ACT College and Workforce Readiness Study concluded the math and reading skills needed to be an electrician/carpenter/plumber are the same needed to be a successful first year college student. **Workforce/College/Military Readiness = High Expectations for ALL.

At least 80% of student body will be authentically recognized at Bobcat Pride for displaying Cat Culture, Positive Peer Interactions, Academic & Growth Mindset. The staff will encourage more genuine peer to peer recognitions with specific help from Sources of Strength, our SEL curriculum, and CAT Culture.

Student attendance will be a priority. The student handbook will be utilized to reinforce attendance expectations.

90% of students will have less than 16 absences for the year.
