





Background Information: GREEN Purpose/Thesis: BLUE Audience Importance: PURPLE The Following: ORANGE Attention Getter: RED

Attention Getter grabs the readers interest and makes them curious about what the rest of the paper has in it.

Attention Getter

Relevant information to the topic, that is connected to real events. (Minimum of 3 sentences)

Attention Getter 3 pts

Provide sentences that grab the attention of the reader about the topic (Minimum of 3 sentences)

Attention Getter

An incomplete sentence, or a statement that has no relationship to the topic. (minimum of 3 sentences)

Attention Getter

The statement is incomplete or statement does not interest the reader. (Less than 3 sentences).

Attention Getter 0 pts

Nothing written

Thesis/Purpose

Introduce what the topic is that the writing will be covering.

Thesis/Purpose

Clearly stated reasons or background information on topic. (Minimum 3 sentences) Thesis/Purpose 3 pts

Clearly state what the reason for this article is. (Minimum of 2 sentences)

Thesis/Purpose

The purpose/thesis does not relate to the topic. (Less than 2 sentences).

Thesis/Purpose

There is no purpose/thesis present. (1 sentence).

Thesis/Purpose 0 pts

No information

Tell the reader why it is important they learn about the topic you are writing about.

Audience Importa...

Provide Sentences that point toward the focus of the evidence based factual article. (minimum 3 sentences)

Audience Importa...

Provide Sentences that clearly state what readers will gain from reading the article. (minimum 2 sentences)

Audience Importa...

Student's importance statement does not relate to the purpose/thesis (Minimum 2 sentences).

Audience Importan...

There is so little information that it does not benefit the reader. (less than 2 sentences). Audience Importa...

The following Paragraphs

This section needs to tell the reader what different subjects you will be writing about in the upcoming paragraphs.

The Following

Introduce 3 or more supporting subjects that relate to the topic. (Minimum 3 sentences)

The Following

3 pts Clearly state what topics the remainder of this article will be about. (Minimum 2 sentences).

The Following

All the subjects are not stated. (Less then 2 sentences).

The Following 1 pt

The subjects listed are not individual paragraphs in you article. (only one sentences).

The Following 0 pts

No information about what the upcoming paragraphs are about.
