Principal Feedback and further questioning	 Workload: Micromanaged? Kinder: A lot of pieces and overwhelmed. Leach pieces, PLC pieces, expectation sheet, unit template, checklists, slides, guided reading lessons, teacher ease, rubrics First: Trying to remember the order to do things. Want to do it right. Some things aren't as clear. Mixed messages between central and admin here. Fixing items because of misconceptions or being told different things. So busy completing paperwork and data and struggling to focus on kids. Schedule is tight and we're worried about being off schedule. Second: Huge weight off when Natalie shared in CTM you are on a schedule, but teachers have freedom to adjust if they need to or have a teachable moment. Schedule is tight and causes anxiety.
