MTSS FLOWCHART

- Identify problem area(s)
 - And describe the problem areas appropriately
- Begin completing the "Teacher: Student Problem Solving Form"
 - Use this to guide your data collection and intervention planning
 - For some information, such as vision and hearing, you will need to ask the nurse or other staff member
- Discuss the student in your MTSS PLC and add to agenda
- Not sure what intervention to use?
 - Review resources in conference room
 - Discuss with PLC
 - Reach out to related service providers
 - Implement with fidelity
- Record intervention on the "Teacher: Student Problem Solving Form"
 - o Include a description and specifics of implementation
 - Include the start and end dates
 - Always implement with fidelity
- Data Collection:
 - o Ensure data is collected in the area targeted by the intervention
 - o After about six weeks, review data to evaluate progress
- Submit the form **electronically** to **School Psychologist Erin Weil**
 - For directions on how to submit the form electronically see the <u>"Directions:</u>
 MTSS Form"
 - Please complete a new form, even if the student has a form completed from a prior year (reference the other form, but complete with current information)
- If the form is completed and interventions are attempted, you will be invited to attend the MTSS Problem Solving Meeting
