- 2. Students will demonstrate and identify how music concepts are used in various styles of music.
- 3. Students will create musical ideas for a specific purpose
- 4. Students will show music literacy by speaking and writing about music and presenting musical concepts through movement and gestures.

## 2nd Grade

- 1. Students will read and perform rhythmic patterns using standard notation.
- 2. Students will demonstrate knowledge of music concepts in music from a variety of cultures.
