











English Language Arts % Proficient over time. Increasing gaps between Parkview and the State.




Forward ELA Grade 5 Percent Proficient






Math % Proficient over time. Increasing gaps between Parkview and the State.



Forward Math Grade 5 Percent Proficient





Pre-pandemic Math Growth of Students with Disabilities










Most current 3rd grade students with disabilities exceeding mean fall to fall reading RIT growth
