## SMART GOALS

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2023-2024 Goals - SMART (number of goals may vary)  
The goals of Pleasant Grove High School are to:

- Stretch Goal (Reading) - The percent of students who score meets grade level on or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 57% to 100% by 2025.
- Stretch Goal (Math) - The percent of students who score meets grade level on or above on STAAR Math will increase from 63% to 100% by 2027.
- Summative Goal 1 - The percentage of students who score Meets or higher on English I & II EOC will increase a minimum of 5 points from 78% points to 83% for the 2024 accountability cycle.
- Summative Goal 2 - The percentage of students who score Meets or higher on Algebra I EOC will increase a minimum of 6 points from 54% to 60% for the 2024 accountability cycle.
- Summative Goal 3- The percentage of students who score Meets or higher on US History EOC will increase a minimum of 4 points from 86% to 90% for the 2024 accountability cycle.
- Summative Goal 4- The percentage of students who score Meets or higher on Biology EOC will increase a minimum of 4 points from 76% to 80% for the 2024 accountability cycle.
- Summative Goal 5 -The percentage of students who meet the college and career readiness indicator will increase a minimum of 4 points from 95% to 99% for the 2024 accountability cycle.
