☐ Focus Unit Plan Template	Focus: Use data to create common instructional plans and common formative assessments.		2nd grade is using extra math and is seeing progress. They used first grade place value lessons to review. Dr. Kenedy said going over comprehension checks with the class is helping students with the wording of the tests. First grade is working on missing addends (retaught with fact families) and making tens. Most friends have mastered reading numbers. With writing numbers students are still struggling with formation.
☐ Teach	Teach: Teachers use Tier I strategies, check for understanding and use common formative assessments.		
☐ Assess <u>Data Analysis Form</u>	Assess: Team analyzes data from common formative assessments and determines next steps.		Ryleigh and Edward are still having trouble in math. Jamiyra and Ainsley are both struggling in math in Dr. Kennedy's class. Both have c averages. Mrs. Plumley's retaught making tens and retested. Students did much better the second time. Adalee in Mrs. Moore's class did better using a ten frame. In KIndergarten, Jaxon is still needing help with unit 2. Mrs. Banister noticed that most of her students are missing 4 and Princeton and Cortarius are having trouble with zero in Mrs. Foster's class.
Respond	Respond: Reteaches and/or enriches based on students' assessed needs.		Second grade introduced place value by reviewing first grade place value. They are testing on Thursday for second grade place value. First grade retaught missing addends with fact families and students did much better on the retest. Mrs. Foster is practicing with students who are still not writing numbers in order.
