# WRITTEN COMPOSITION SUMMARY – GRADE 4

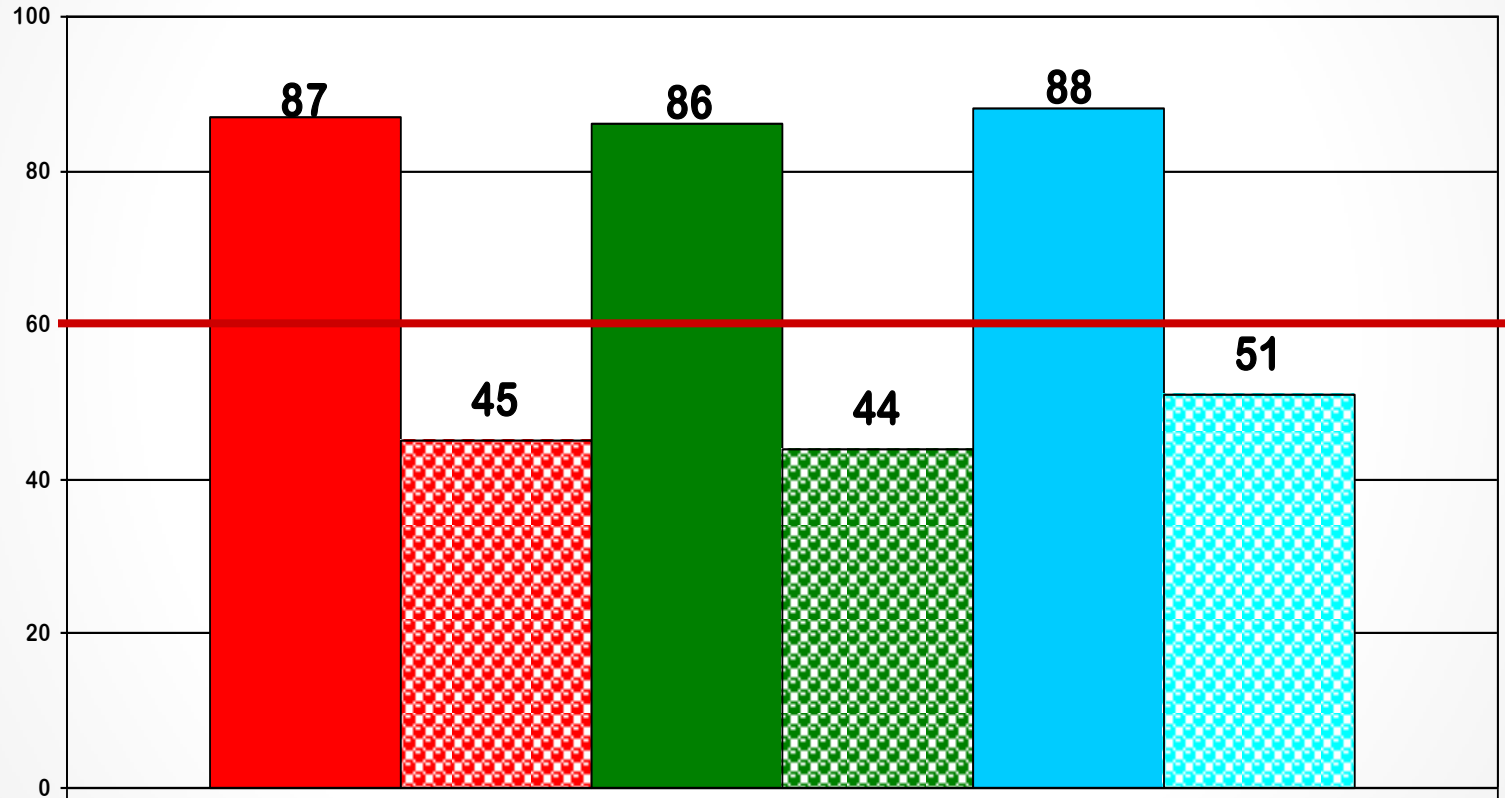
## Percent at each Rating Level

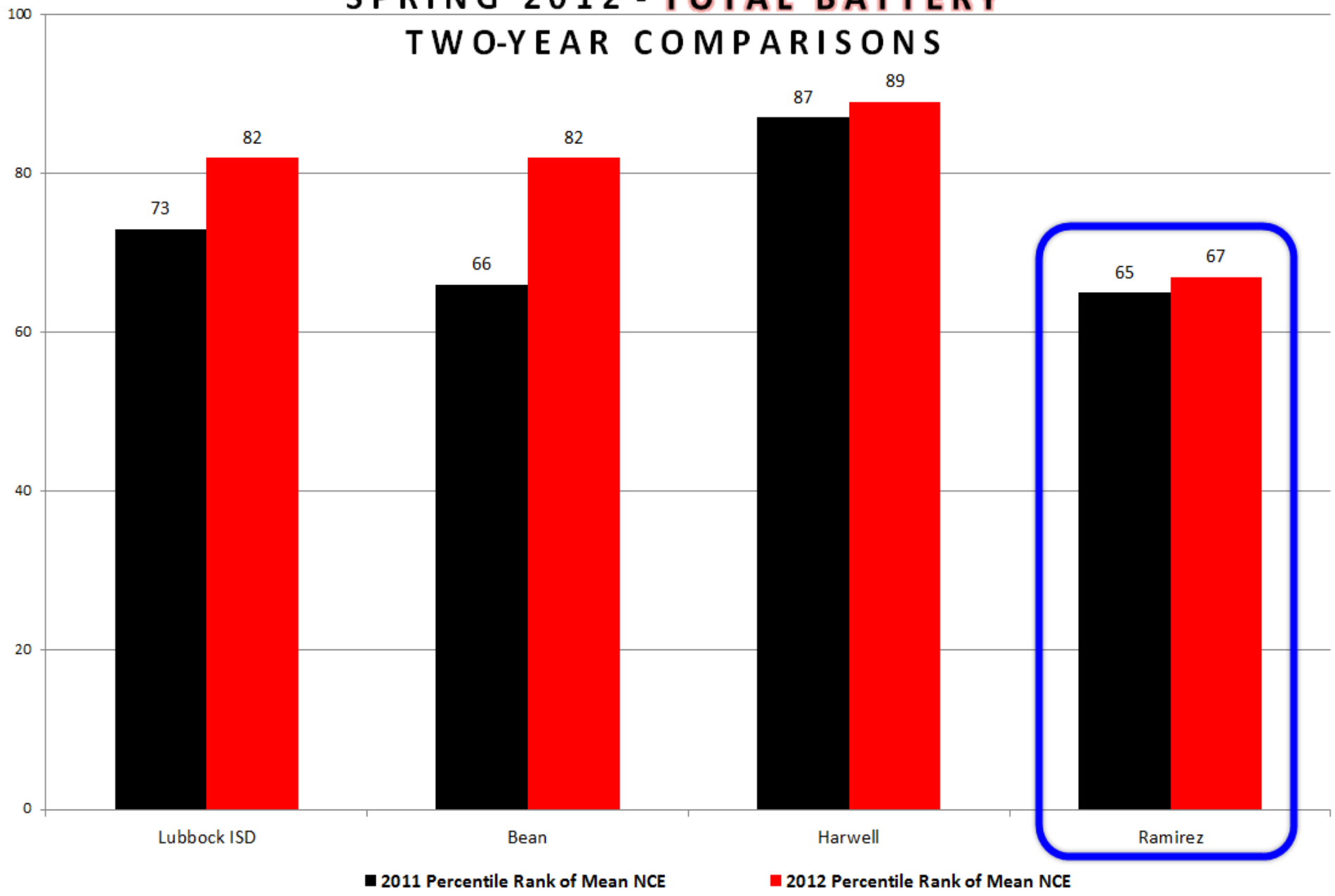

3, 4, 4, 5, 7, 10, 11, 12, 14, 16, 17, 18

Cut it into quarters:

3, 4, 4 | 5, 7, 10 | 11, 12, 14 | 16, 17, 18

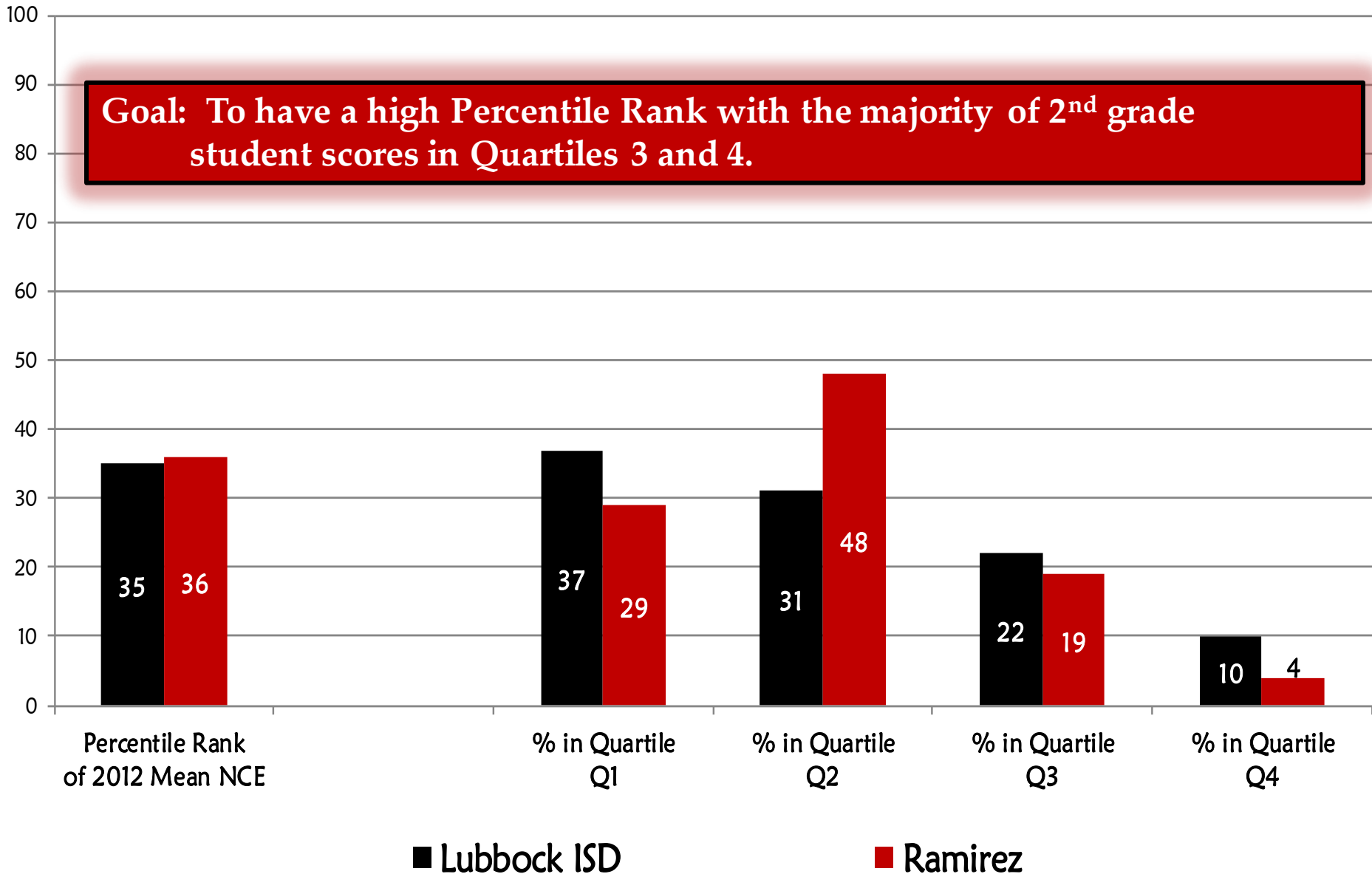

## TOTAL BATTERY by QUARTILE

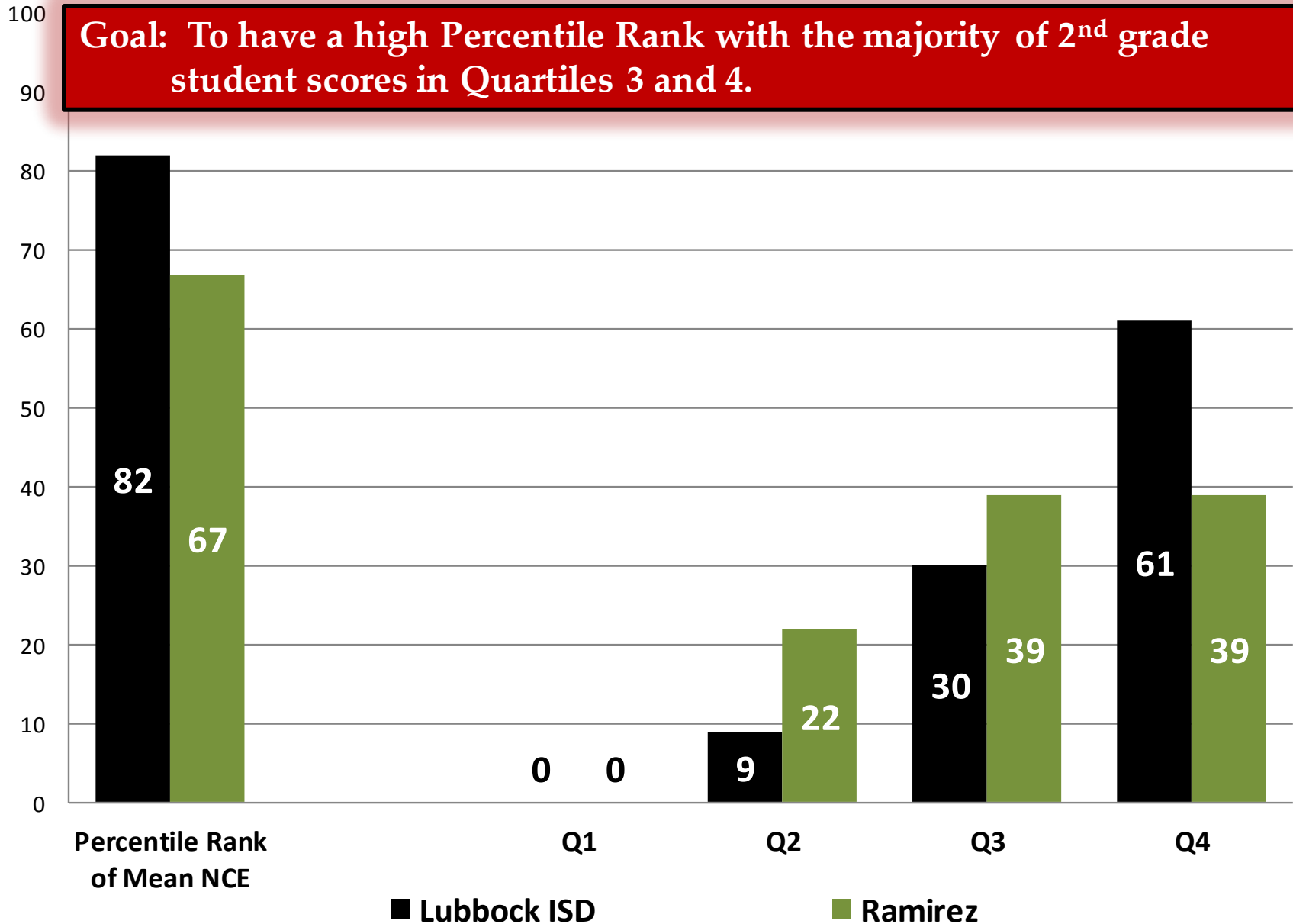

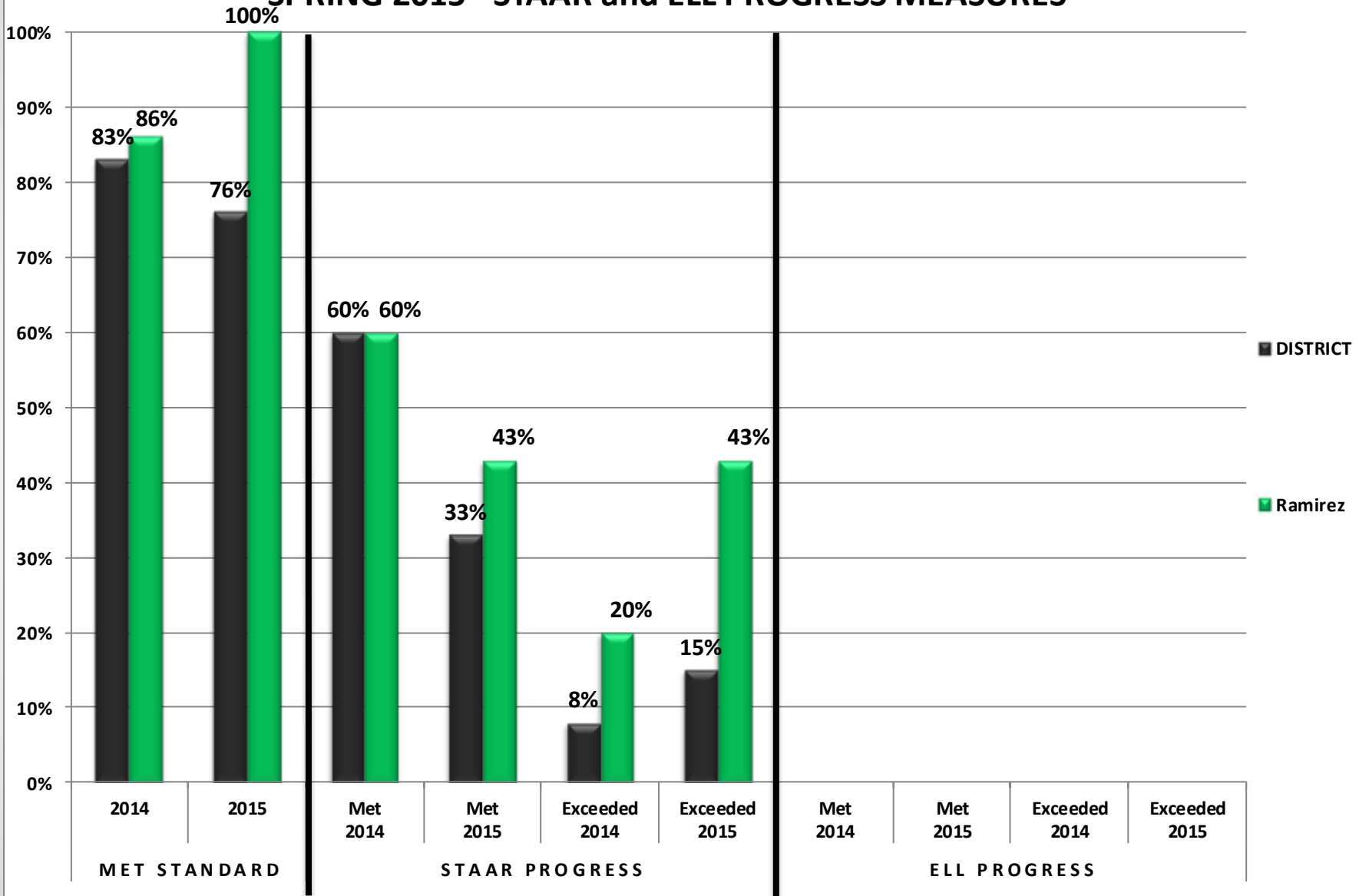

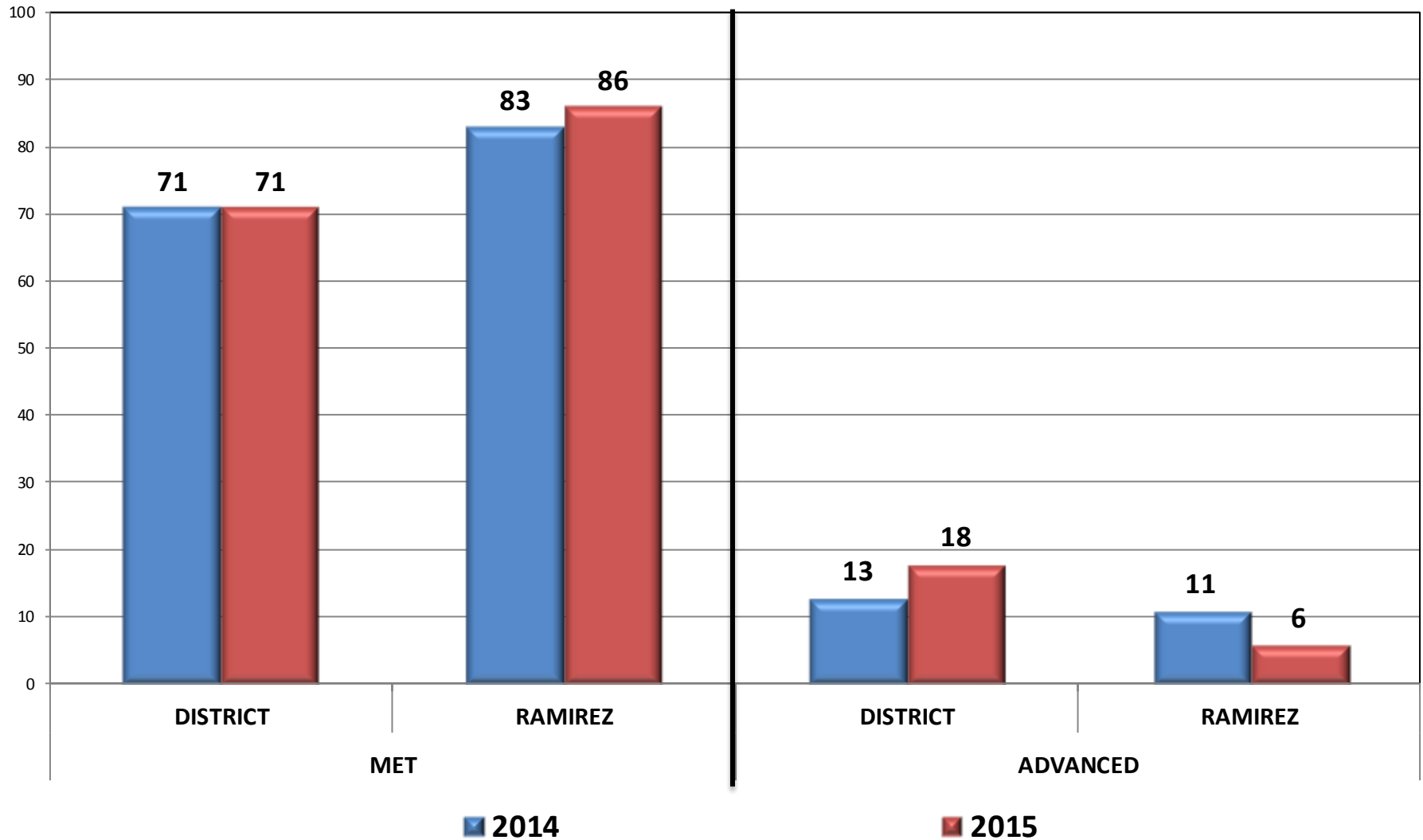

Overall student growth from Grade 3 to Grade 4

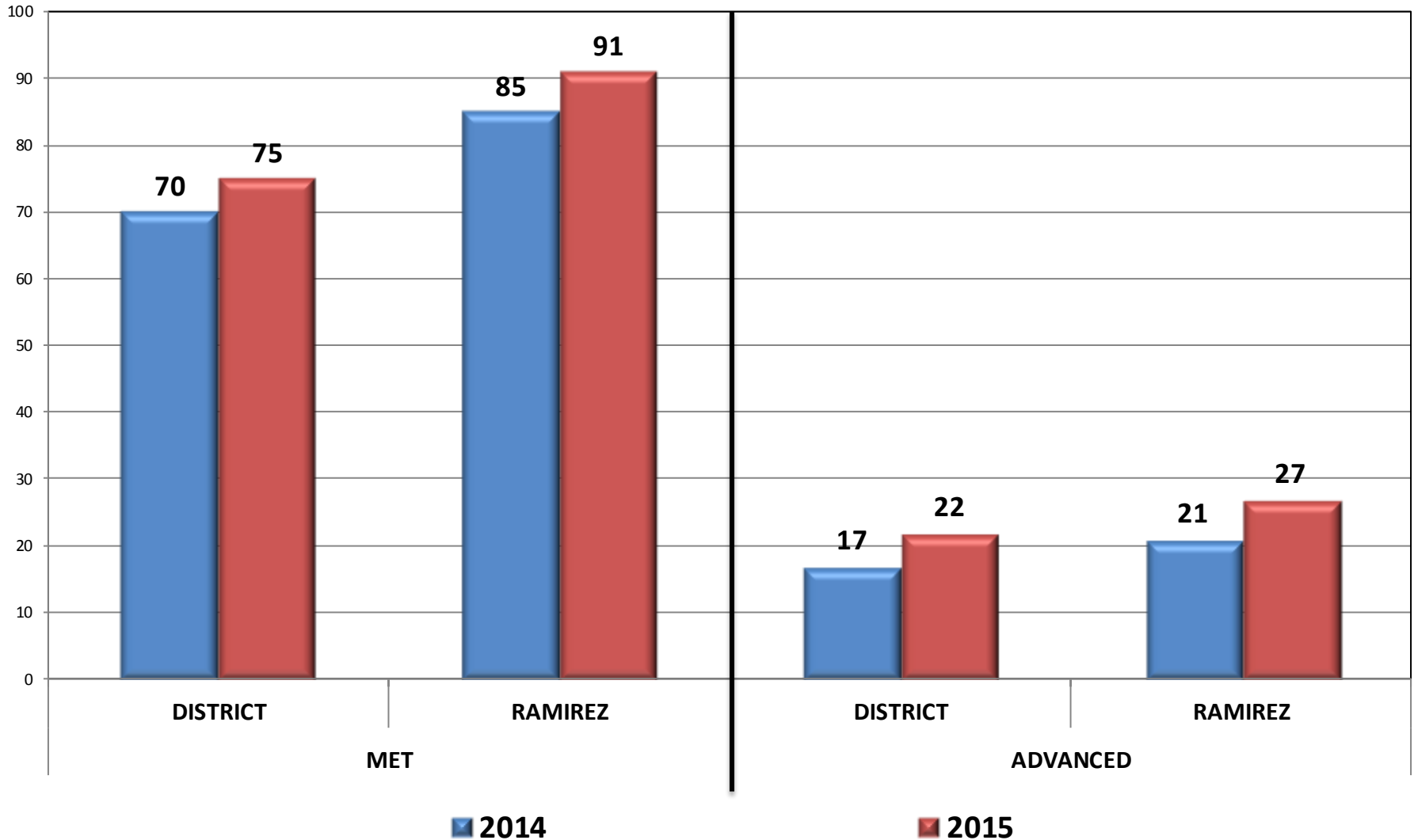

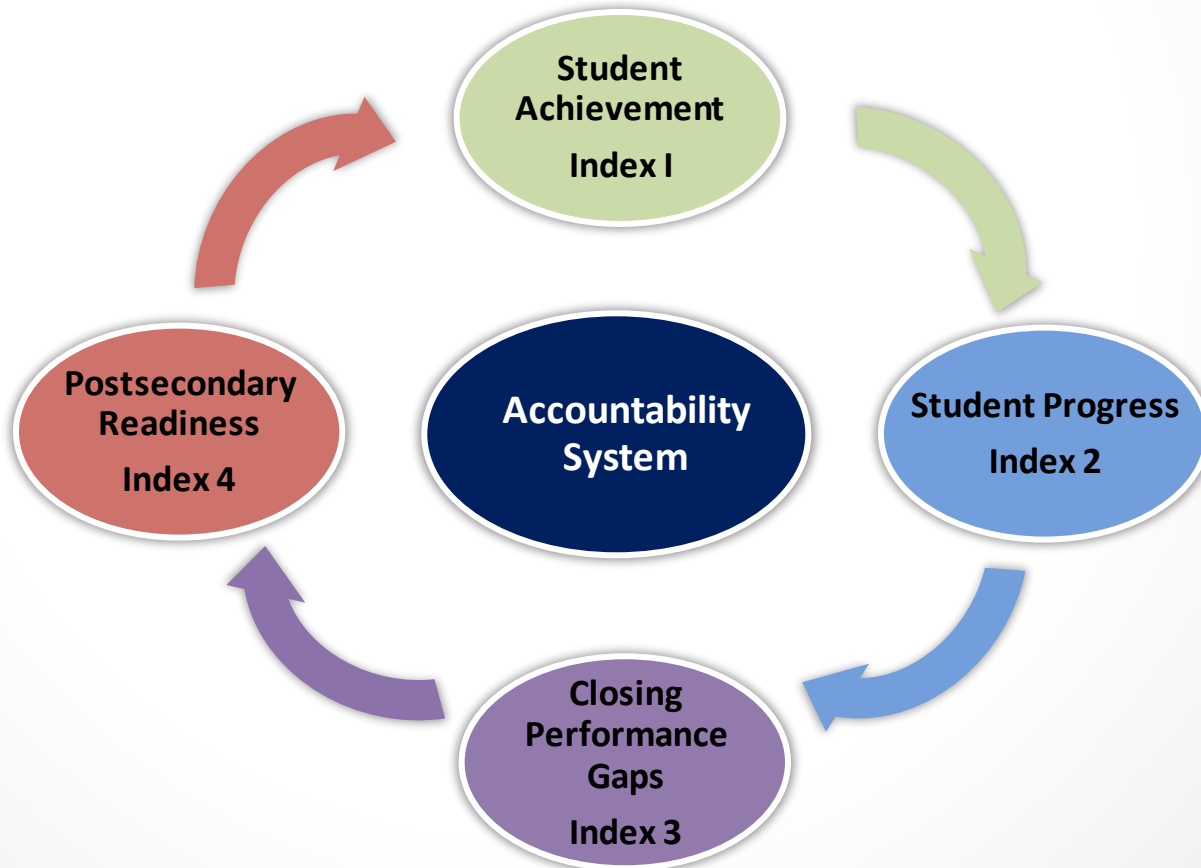

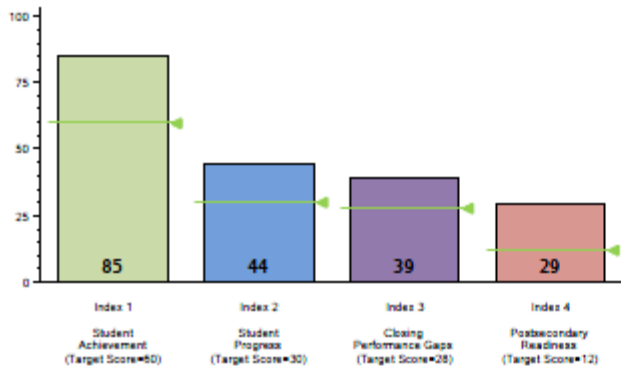
