I wanted to thank you for allowing Siloam Springs Schools to visit your campus on Thursday, March 30 during the morning half of the day.

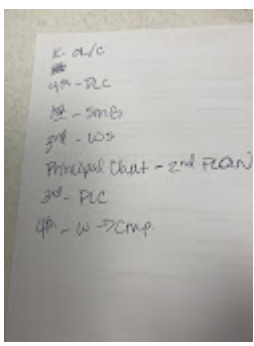
