Unwrapping Standards using Teacher Clarity enhanced my knowledge in the following areas.



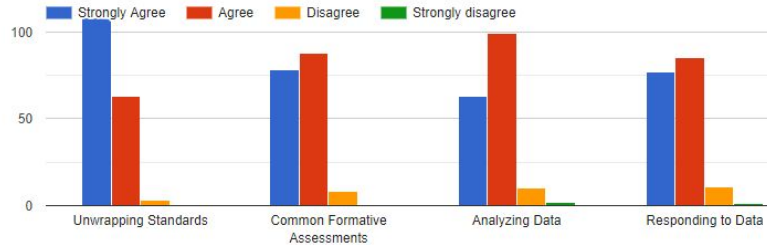

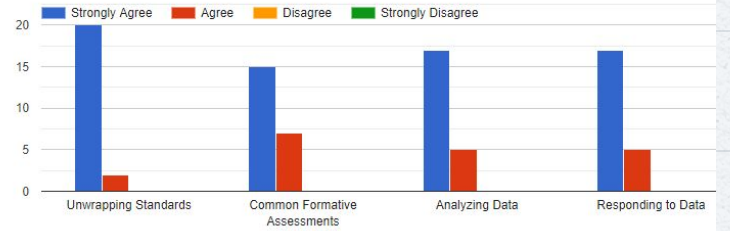
