# WHAT IS THE DRAFT?



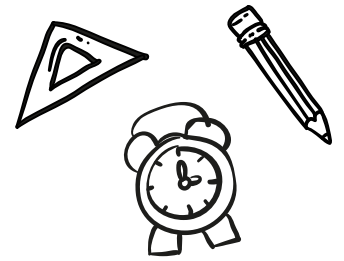
Content teachers will pull students into small groups to reteach, review materials, test, or meet with students weekly during 2nd period.

# WIN DRAFT (HOW IT WORKS)



- Each week the WIN draft sheet will be sent out on Wednesday for teachers to begin drafting students.
- Priority teacher groups will draft students that are needed for remedial practice, test taking, make up work, or other specified needs
- Secondary and remaining teacher groups will then be able to draft from the remaining students.
- \*Priority and secondary teacher groups will rotate each week (ELA/SS & Math/Sc).

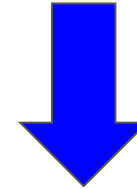
# WHO DRAFTS WHEN?



- Draft sheet will be sent out on Wednesday.
- Content area teachers must have the draft completed by Monday morning at 8:00am. **(NON-NEGOTIABLE)**
  - Priority Content Teachers- **draft in red**
  - Secondary Content Teachers- **draft in blue**
  - Guidance will have last priority to pull small groups
  - Groups must have between 12-16 students
- Students who are not drafted will be placed in program and enrichment classes by the PLC Coordination Team on Monday.

# PROGRAM CLASSES

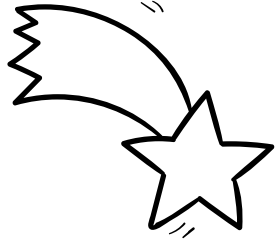

# WINTERVENTION MONDAY

- All students have the opportunity for outside time.
  - 6th- outside the round wing
  - 7th- on the blacktop
  - 8th- on the football field
- If students have missing assignments still on the list from the previous week, they will go to the cafeteria with King/Pruitt and one grade level teacher ([see rotation](#)).
- Students will leave their belongings in their 1st period class and pick them up on the way to their 3rd period.
- If it rains this day, students will report to their WIN time teacher assigned in PowerSchool for free time. \*Review this [document](#) for free time guidelines.

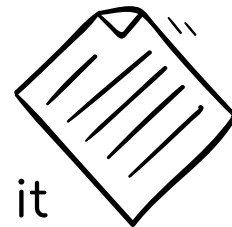
# BUBBLE KIDS (FRIDAY)



- ELA and Math teachers will review iReady and SCREADY scores and identify students who are at “approaches” in their subject area.
  - Students will be drafted according to skills they need additional support with.
  - Groups will be between 12-16 in each class.
- All other CORE teachers will be able to draft from the remaining students.
  - Groups must be between 12-16 students.

\*\* All other students will be placed with program and enrichment teachers and placed accordingly by the PLC Coordination Team.

# MISSING WORK GOOGLE SHEET



- Each week the Missing Work Google Sheet is live (keep it updated!).
- Any work missing for the students CONTENT area classes must be added to the sheet by Monday at 8am of each week.
- When a student completes the work, they must contact the teacher (via email or Google Sheet) to let the teacher know the work is complete. It is at each teacher's discretion how you would like your students to communicate that they've completed their work.
- Only the teacher who added the work is allowed to take the work off of the list.

# THINGS TO REMEMBER:

1. WIN Draft sheet will be made available on Wednesday of each week.
  - Priority and Secondary content areas will be listed at the top.
2. WIN Draft sheet must be completed by 8am on Monday morning. It will be a live document and the teacher that posted the assignment will be responsible for deleting it.
3. Missing Work Google sheet must be completed by 8am on Monday morning.
4. You will know who your students are for the remainder of the week on Monday.
  - Make sure to create a roster for yourself for the week.

# Career Connections Grades

## End of the Week:

- Log into iReady and check your students' work for the week for completion of lessons with 75% or higher in both ELA and Math.
- Complete the chart to assess each student's week for the weekly grade.

2.5 points	70
2 points	60

1 point	40
.5 points	30

**Students can show you their score after they finished a lesson. You will need to check under their "Completed Work." They do know how to manipulate the numbers, so you will still need to check in iReady for completion.**



# Career Connections Things to Know...

## Career Connections Teachers:

- Actively monitor students while they are working.
- Check the missing work Google Sheet to let students know what work they owe.
- Use Career Connections Grade Checklist each week to record grades.

## Core Teachers:

- Check iReady for completed lessons and give tokens based on completed lessons. (8 completed lessons per Math/ELA= 1 token)
- Take off work from the missing work list as students complete it.

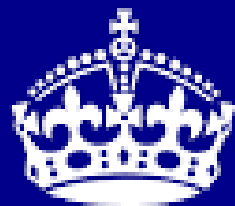
